

Long Range Planning
In this stage, future land use and projected traffic volumes are examined. This serves as the basis for the determination of the need for new or upgraded roads.



PD&E Study
This stage identifies the location and conceptual design of road improvements. The environmental and social impacts are then evaluated.



Project Design
If a design build alternative is selected, construction plans are prepared.



Right-of-Way Acquisition
If additional land is needed for roadway right-of-way, then it is purchased.



Construction
The desired design build alternative for the roadway is constructed.



"No Build" Alternative Selection



Routine Maintenance
If the "No Build" alternative is selected, then roadways will stay as they are and will require only routine maintenance.
